## GUIDELINES FOR CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE PROCEEDINGS WITH ISBN

Instructions for conference participants to follow:

- Recommended length of the paper is 4 pages, A4 format, do not number the pages
- Word, font type Times New Roman, font size 12, line spacing 1, all margins 3 cm, block alignment
- Title of the paper in Czech (Slovak) and English, bold, font size 14, centered, English title in italics
- Names of authors (without academic degrees, in bold), indicate the affiliation on the next line, centered
- Leave 1 line space
- Summary in Czech (Slovak) and English
- After leaving 1 line space – Key words (in italics), in Czech (Slovak) and English
- After leaving 1 line space – Main text
- Figures and Tables incorporated in text
- Citing information resources should follow the proceedings template
- Contact address

Full texts of all accepted papers will be published in the online proceedings.

The Conference organizing committee reserves the right to return all papers that do not meet the guidelines for reprocessing or they will not be published.
